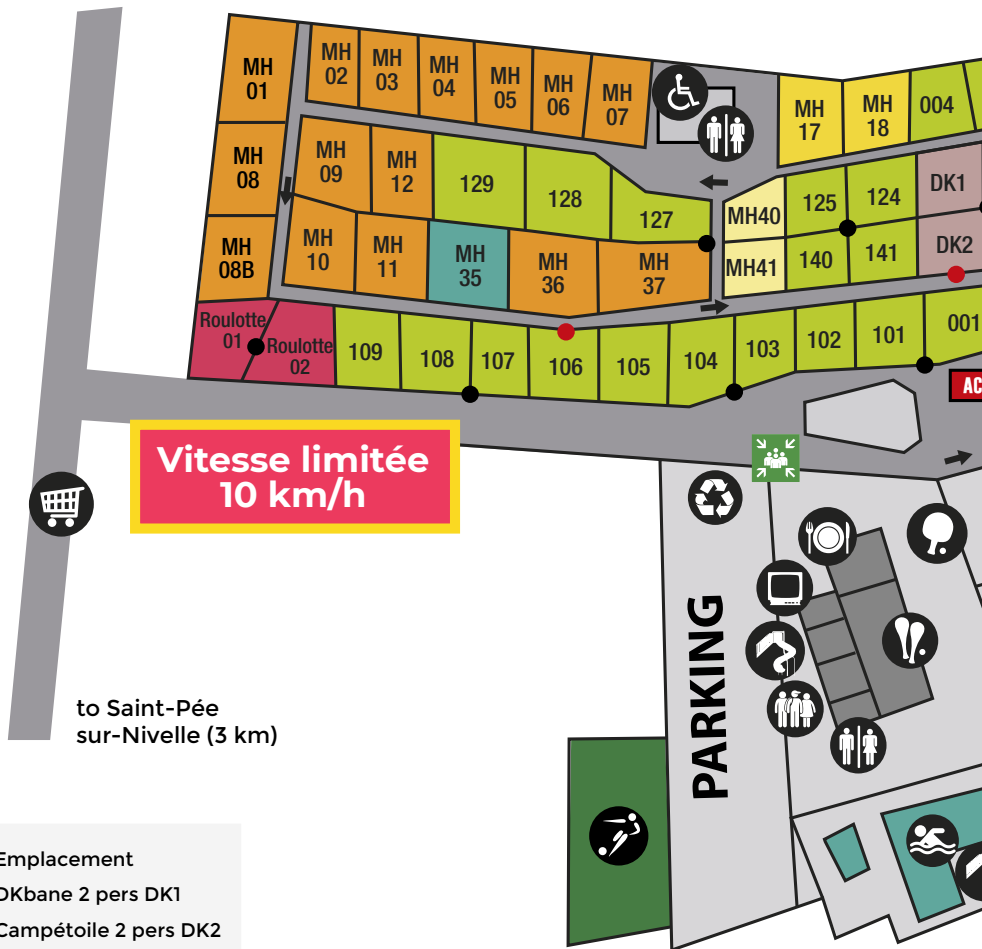

# Reception

You will find at reception a small convenience shop, battery recycling, charcoal BBQ loan (reservation required), post-cards (€0.50), frozen water bottles for coolers (€1), and hiking guides (deposit €10).

The campsite is closed from 10:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m., so please leave your vehicles in the parking area during those hours. During the day, you may park your vehicle next to your pitch. If you have a second vehicle, it must be parked in the parking area (€3/day).

Dogs and cats must be kept on a leash, even around your tent. Their vaccination record must be up to date. Pets must relieve themselves outside the campsite (not in the parking area). You will find waste bags at the campsite entrance. Do not leave your dog alone in the tent or caravan when you are away.

On the day of your departure, you must leave your pitch before 11:30 a.m., or your rental between 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. (for rentals, please remember to schedule a check-out appointment no later than the day before your departure).

# Services



## Sanitary Facilities

You will find 2 sanitary blocks on the campsite.

Please respect the closing hours of the sanitary blocks for cleaning and use the one that remains open.

Please accompany children to the toilets. A children's shower is available in the upper sanitary block (key to be collected at reception), as well as a baby bathtub.

For the comfort of those around the sanitary facilities, the showers and dishwashing sinks are closed from 10:30 PM to 7:00 AM, and the washbasins are closed from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM (washbasins near the toilets remain open).

You will find a waste water disposal point in each sanitary block.

It is forbidden to play in the sanitary blocks.

Water is not infinite, let's not waste it. The planet says thank you.



## Laundry

In the upper sanitary block, you will find 2 washing machines (€5), a coin-operated dryer (€3) available at reception. There are 2 ironing boards, and an iron is available for loan at reception.



## Motorhome Service

Located at the entrance of the campsite. You can empty your waste water and grey water. To fill up with water, please collect the key at reception.

# Sports, games, hikes

## On the campsite, you will find :

- A fronton (pala and balls are next to the fronton), two ping-pong tables (paddles available next to the covered table, balls for sale at reception for €1), a pétanque court, a football field, and a volleyball/badminton court (balls and rackets to be picked up at reception, with an adult).
- A Community room open from 8:00 AM to midnight, with a football table.
- A TV room open from 8:00 AM to 11:30 PM, with a library.
- Outdoor and indoor games open from 8:30 AM to 8:30 PM, under the responsibility of the parents.

We organize full-day and half-day hikes from 07/07 to 24/08. Descriptions, dates, and times are posted on the board to the right of the reception.

We host a welcome gathering every Monday at 7:00 PM from 07/07 to 27/08.

We do not organize evening entertainment in order to preserve the peace. This is why we ask everyone to keep noise to a minimum after 11:00 PM.

The village of Saint-Pée-sur-Nivelle is typical of the Basque Country, with its main shopping street and beautiful Labourdine houses.

The Saint Peter's Church, classified as a historical monument, was built at the end of the 15th century and renovated in the 18th century.

The Ecomuseum of Pelote and Xistera: «Did you know? The xistera (a wicker glove used to play Basque pelota) was invented in Saint-Pée-sur-Nivelle. Don't hesitate to visit the museum to become an expert on the different disciplines of Basque pelota.

The lake is located 5 km from the campsite on the road to Espelette. You can go for a walk, swim, pedal boat, kayak, slide down the large inflatable structure, try the zipline, and more...»



# Hikes

## LES HAUTS D'IBARRON ET LE ZUHALMENDI

INTERMEDIATE LEVEL



10,7 km

From the Ibarron fronton, **1** go straight ahead, then turn left, cross the Nivelles river over the stone bridge. Pass in front of a large farmhouse **2**. Continue straight after the farmhouse.

Before the fork in the road, take a small wooden bridge on your left **3**. It goes uphill. Then turn left and continue to climb. Join a wider path and turn right **4**. At the first intersection, turn right **5**. At the second intersection, turn right again **6**. At the fork, leave the main path, turn left, and pass in front of a palombière (a traditional hunting lodge, part of the Saint Jacques de Compostelle pilgrimage route) **7**.

Climb and descend on a grassy path. Then, turn right when you join a wider gravel path (part of the Saint Jacques de Compostelle pilgrimage route).

When you reach the paved road, turn right **8**. At the fork, turn left and stay on the paved road **9**. Then, turn left onto the path that climbs to the top of Zuhalmendi (GR8 ORTILLOPITZ SARE yellow sign) **10**. Climb to the summit and enjoy a 360° view **11**.

Descend via the path to the right of the one you ascended (go see the Kintoa pigs), then at the bottom, turn right onto the gravel road **12**.

Follow the road until you reach the first houses and turn immediately left **13**.

Follow the wide path. When you reach the sheepfold, turn right **13**. Later, turn right again (Santa Barbara return to Ibarron yellow sign) **14**.

Continue the descent until you reach the road, continue straight, and pass the Canadian gate. Take the path on your right to cross the stone bridge again.

Return to your car.





## WALK TO SAINTE-BARBE

NIVEAU MOYEN



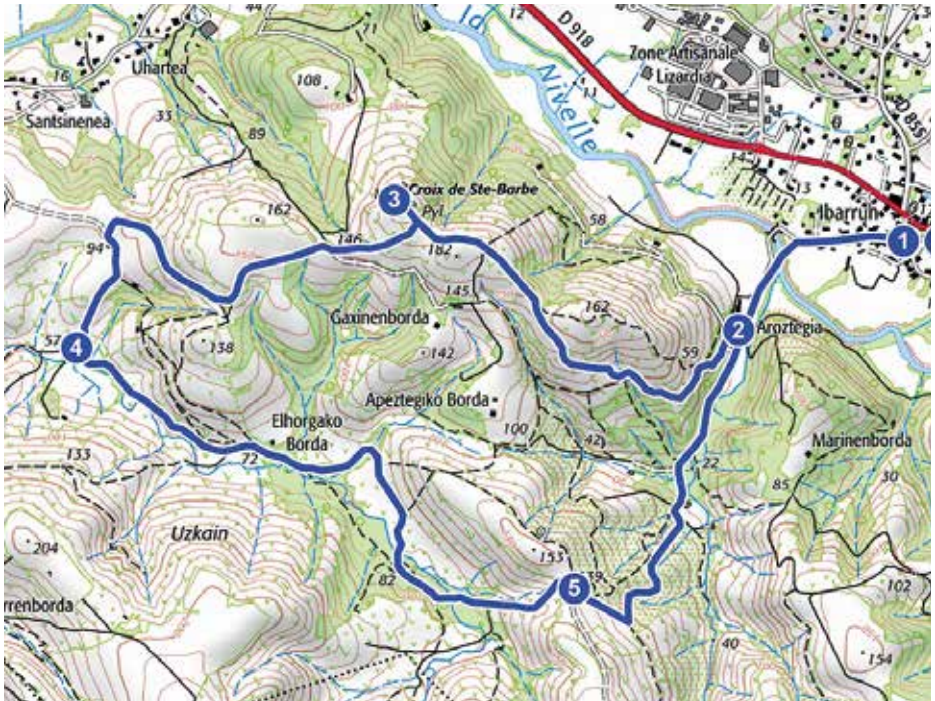
From the pediment at Ibarro, follow a tarmac road to the bridge la Vierge where you will be able to cross the Nivelles **1**.

Straight after the large farm at Aroztegia, follow the road which leads upwards for 100m. **2**

Take the path on your left. When you arrive at the esplanade, follow the path on the right hand side which leads upwards, follow the markings until you reach the top of the hill at Sainte-Barbe with its cross **3**.

Follow the same path for 50m on the way down and take the path which leads to the right. Climb over the stile and walk through the field. Continue on the main path. Take the next left fork **4**, pass in front of a sheepfold and walk down to the bottom of the valley to the stream **5**.

Follow the stream and enjoy the cool air. After crossing two fords **6**, climb up the left hand slope of the valley, and follow the main path until you get to the mountain pass **7**. Climb down opposite to regain your starting place.

## THE COAST

- Biarritz (Miarritze): Stroll from the Grande Plage to the Port Vieux beach.
- Bidart (Bidarte): Enjoy its charming square, cliffs, and the Erreteguia beach.
- Guéthary (Getari): Walk down to the small fishing port.
- Saint-Jean-de-Luz (Donibane Lohizune): Take a walk along the beach to the Sainte Barbe hill. Visit the fishing port and the Socoa fort.
- Hendaye (Hendaia): Walk along the beautiful corniche, the stunning cliff between Socoa and Hendaye. A very nice beach.
- Fontarrabie (Hondarribia): A very pretty medieval village.
- Saint-Sébastien (Donosti): Take the Topo (train) from Hendaye to visit La Concha beach, the old town, and Mount Igeldo. If you want to drive there, don't forget to request prior authorization on the website donostia.eus, otherwise you'll face a €200 fine.

## BAYONNE (BAIONA)

Between the Nive and the Adour, Bayonne is a historic, lively, and gastronomic city. Stroll through the Grand and Petit Bayonne historic districts, with its ramparts, medieval streets, cathedral, and cloister.



## THE MOST BEAUTIFUL BASQUE VILLAGE

- Sare (Sara): Don't miss the village square at the foot of the Rhune mountain and the beautiful Basque houses.
- Espelette (Ezpeleta): Known primarily for its chili peppers, it's a lovely village perfect for strolling.
- Ainhoa (Ainhoa): A bastide village with a unique street lined with half-timbered Labourdine-style houses.
- Saint-Jean-Pied-de-Port (Donibane Garaizi): Discover its fortified town, the Citadelle street, and the Saint Jacques gate.
